

## 2021/2022 Water Rate Schedule

### 2020/2021 Rates

\$119.45 per E.U.  
\$ 3.90 per 1,000 gallons for metered acts.  
\$ 85.29 vacancy rate to cover fixed costs.

### 2021/2022 Rates (effective 7/1/21)

\$122.40 per E.U.  
\$ 4.05 per 1,000 gallons for metered acts.  
\$ 93.02 vacancy rate to cover fixed costs

- The vacancy rate covers the fixed costs, which currently represent 76% of the budget.
- 2021/2022 is a 2.47% increase per E.U. over 2020/2021.

## 2021/2022 Sewer Rate Schedule

### 2020/2021 Rates

\$182.56 per E.U.  
\$ 12.26 per 1,000 gallons for metered acts.  
\$120.23 vacancy rate to cover fixed costs.

### 2021/2022 Rates (effective 7/1/21)

\$186.21 per E.U.  
\$13.04 per 1,000 gallons for metered acts.  
\$146.54 vacancy rate to cover fixed costs

- The vacancy rate covers the fixed costs, which currently represent 78.7% of the budget.
- The 2021/2022 is a 1.99% increase per E.U. over 2020/2021.

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### Water Project Construction Update

GW Tatro will be installing new water main and valves from 35 North Main Street to 69 North Main Street, Clifford Drive, Cushing Drive and Densmore Street. Two more fire hydrants will be installed, along with a State mandated water sampling station on Pleasant Street. A second layer of blacktop will be applied to Avon Drive and Livery Stable and trench patching on Main Street. Some infrastructure on Main Street will also be brought up to grade.

This is a construction project, so the schedule is subject to change and emergency shut offs may occur. Any residents or businesses that are scheduled to be shut off will be given at least 24 hours' notice.

### Future Plans

Engineering is already underway for the next phase of rehabilitating the water system. This next phase will include new water main, valves and services to customers on Sand Hill, Bicentennial Lane, Krystal Drive, Graham Street and Highland Avenue, along with some new fire hydrants.
