### MEETING MINUTES

THURSDAY, MAY 4, 2017

- A. The meeting was called to order at 6:36 pm. with Dietre Feeney, Ele Griffin, Katie Sault, and Corey Stearns in attendance.
- B. Katie Sault attended our meeting to share how the upcoming pool season is shaping up to open June 26<sup>th</sup>. She showed us the brochure for the 2017 summer.
