

Minutes of the September 4, 2011 Emergency Meeting of the Board of Selectmen.

Present: Neal Fox, Bill Richards, Joe De Freitas, Delbert Cloud, Health Officer Erin Boettcher, State Senator Richard McCormack, and Sandra Levesque.

Although originally called for 3:30 PM, the meeting was delayed in starting, and was called to order at approximately 4:30 PM by Chairman Neal Fox. Given that Sandra Levesque had noted initially that her services to the Town to assist in the hurricane Irene recovery would be limited to only a few days, discussion focused first on how to continue disseminating information upon her departure.

Health Officer Erin Boettcher expressed her concerns over the unprepared volunteers, emphasizing the importance of training and equipping them appropriately for the work in which they would be engaged. Various measures were set forth to provide this.

Regarding the use of the Town water system, it was noted that no contamination had been found in the water and the "boil water" notice had been issued by the Town solely as a precaution due to the vulnerability of the water sources to the impacts of hurricane Irene. It was thus agreed that when favorable reports are available from the contracted laboratory on both VOC's and coliform, such notice should be lifted.

With no further business to attend, motion to adjourn was made at approximately 6:00 PM by Bill Richards, seconded by Joe De Freitas and unanimously carried.
