

Minutes of the October 3, 2011 Meeting of the Board of Selectmen.

The meeting was called to order at 7:45 PM by Chairman Neal Fox. The meeting was called as a "special meeting" to learn of plans being developed by the Vermont Agency of Transportation (AOT) for reconstruction of Vermont State Route 107. These plans were explained by Mark A. Colgan, P.E. of the firm Vanesse Hangen Brustlin, Inc., his firm being employed by the AOT to oversee the reconstruction project. Discussion ensued regarding the merit of hauling materials by rail vs. trucks. Neal Fox suggested that parties should discuss privately the relative merits of the methods. Motion was made by Bill Richards, seconded by Joe De Freitas and unanimously carried to authorize closure of Peavine Boulevard as needed to accomplish delivery whenever resolved as to methodology.

June Tierney volunteered to attend an upcoming Hazard Mitigation Grant Program workshop. Chairman Fox informed her that a representative from the Town Office was scheduled to attend.

A question was raised with regard to the minutes from the September 19, 2011 meeting and was deferred as it was not an item listed on the agenda.
