MEETING MINUTES

THURSDAY, APRIL 6, 2017

- A. The meeting was called to order at 6:37pm. with Corey Stearns, Dietre Feeney, Willy Walker, and Ele Griffin in attendance.
- B. Vermont Symphony Dinner Event: Corey informed the committee that for best case scenario 30 tickets for the dinner are committed by people.
